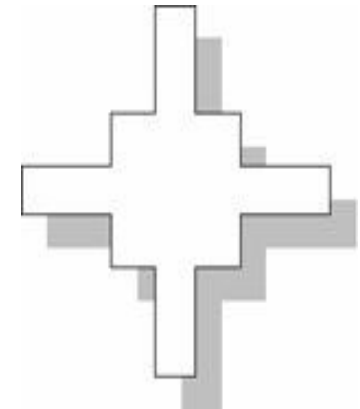
Directions to entrance on Church Street:
