

2012 Knott Scholars announced

Twenty-one boys and girls in the Archdiocese of Baltimore have been awarded 2012 Knott scholarships. Funded by the Marion Burk Knott Scholarship Fund and the Marion I. and Henry J. Knott Scholarship Fund, the awards have an estimated four-year tuition value of more than \$1 million.

According to a news release, scholarships are awarded to the highest-ranking applicants based on a variety of academic and standardized test scores.
