

2015 Knott Scholarships awarded

The Knott Scholarship Funds have announced the winners of the 2015 Knott Scholarship Competition. These scholarships, funded by the Marion Burk Knott Scholarship Fund and the Marion I. and Henry J. Knott Scholarship Fund, have an estimated four-year tuition value of nearly \$1.3 million.

Since its inception in 1981, Knott Scholarships have funded more than 1,300 scholars. This represents more than \$20 million in tuition grants paid to Baltimore-area Catholic schools.
