## Archbishop's Annual Appeal launches Feb. 8

The Archbishop's Annual Appeal, a fundraising effort to support parishes, schools, Catholic Charities, and numerous other ministries throughout the Archdiocese of Baltimore, will officially launch Feb. 8-9.
