

Cardinal O'Malley among 'Francis Factor' panelists at Loyola U

Cardinal Sean P. O'Malley, Archbishop of Boston and a member of Pope Francis' advisory Council of Cardinals, will give the keynote address and be among the panelists at "The Francis Factor," an event that will be held at Loyola University Maryland's Reitz Arena March 18 at 7 p.m. to mark the one-year anniversary of the election of the pope.
