A MESSAGE FROM JIM HAMILTON, CHAIR APPEAL ALLOCATIONS OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE

Dear Friends,

As Chairman of the Archbishop’s Annual Appeal Allocation Oversight Committee, it is my pleasure to present you with this year-end review of the 2018 Appeal, *Together In Mission*. In this summary report, you will find:

- how your parish performed compared to its 2018 Annual Appeal goal,
- the top uses for Appeal monies that were rebated to parishes like yours, and
- a listing of how Appeal funds were used to strengthen the evangelizing and charitable outreach ministries that help the Archdiocese carry out the work of Christ every day.

It is no secret that 2018 proved a difficult one for our Church, both locally and universally. However, even given this challenge, over 27,000 individuals, families, and organizations unified *Together In Mission* to raise nearly \$9 million in gifts and commitments and to help 60 of our parishes reach their Appeal goals.

This remarkable outcome is a testament to the oft-unrecognized efforts of pastors, parish staffs and committees, Appeal lay co-chairs Ralph and Christine Arnold and Dave and Kristen Kinkopf, guest speakers, and volunteers. I would like to take this opportunity to thank them here. To all who toiled in service to the 2018 Appeal, please know that you have made a profound difference in the lives of thousands of your fellow faithful and for many of our community’s most underserved citizens, who, otherwise, might languish in a world without hope.

As funds raised from the Annual Appeal fuel so many initiatives that enliven our charitable and evangelizing mission as mandated by Jesus to His Apostles, I thought it might be helpful to describe the role of the Allocations Oversight Committee. Meeting twice a year, the Annual Appeal Allocations Oversight Committee, comprised of parish pastors, lay volunteers such as I, and archdiocesan staff, reviews Appeal funds raised to-date and ensures that they will be allocated in accordance with the Appeal’s Spending Plan. It bears repeating that Appeal funds are never used for purposes other than those stipulated in the Spending Plan, which does not include legal costs incurred by the Archdiocese for any reason. Please know that the oversight of our committee ensures that your sacrificial gifts are always stewarded as you intend.

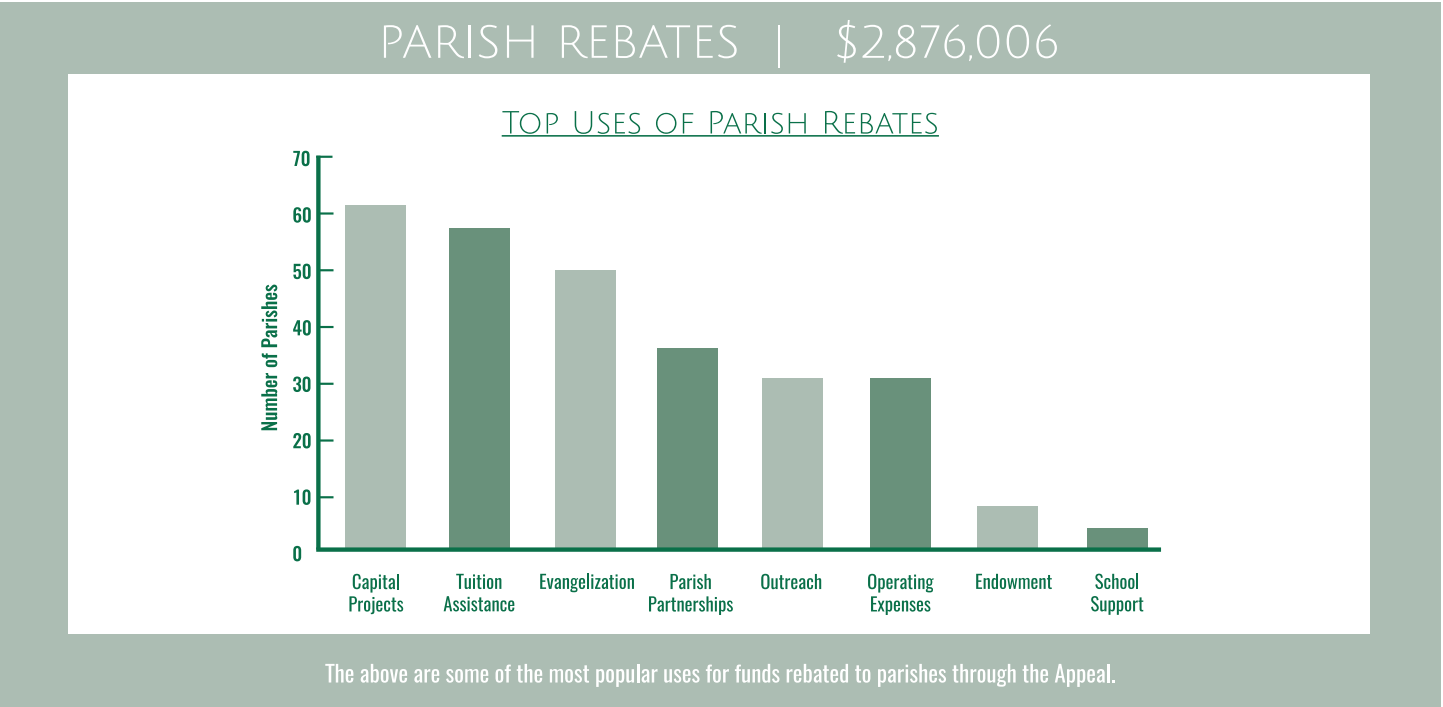
