# A MESSAGE FROM JIM HAMILTON, CHAIR APPEAL ALLOCATIONS OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE

It bears repeating that Appeal funds are never used for purposes other than those stipulated in the Spending Plan, which does not include legal costs incurred by the Archdiocese for any reason. Please know that the oversight of our committee ensures that your sacrificial gifts are always stewarded as you intend.


