Rally Wednesday for Textbook Funding Relief

A rally to encourage continued Maryland General Assembly support for a textbook loan program for non-public school students is scheduled for the Saint Ursula School auditorium in Parkville, Maryland at 7:00 p.m. on Wednesday, January 31, 2001.

The program enables the state to purchase non-religious textbooks for loan to children attending non-public schools. Last year, the General Assembly approved Governor Glendening's request for a first year program investment of \$6 million. The Governor's proposed \$21 billion budget for fiscal 2002 requests \$8 million for the program. Students, parents, teachers, administrators and others from schools around the region will gather Wednesday evening to demonstrate their concern and discuss advocacy efforts toward achieving a continuation of textbook funding in the 2002 state budget.
