Scrutinize CCHD grants

I wonder again why the Catholic Campaign for Human Development continues to grant funds (\$60,000) to organizations such as People Acting Together in Howard, "CCHD Grants Empower Poor" (CR, Sept. 1).

PATH is an affiliate of the Industrial Areas Foundation (IAF). It is one thing for the Church to have an option for the poor and something else to fund an organization or one of its affiliates whose fundamental principles contradict the social teaching of the church.
