Steeple of Historic Church Destroyed, Church Closed Indefinitely

St. Patrick Catholic Church in Fells Point is closed due to damage incurred from today's 5.9 magnitude earthquake. The historic church's steeple and bell tower were badly damaged, rendering the church unsafe for use.

St. Patrick's was founded in 1792 and the current church was completed in 1898. It is owned by the Archdiocese of Baltimore. Father Robert Wojtek, Pastor of Sacred Heart of Jesus, oversees its operation.
