World calls for just, two-state Israeli-Palestinian settlement

"Human rights report details water crisis in West Bank" (CR, Aug.7) states that "... the chronic water shortage is due in large part to Israel's discriminatory policy in distributing the joint water resources in the West Bank." In other words, while illegal Israeli settlers are filling their swimming pools, Palestinians barely have enough drinking water. Each year, Israel steals more Palestinian land and water in the West Bank, while maintaining its deadly siege and collective punishment on Palestinians in the Gaza Strip.
