Steve Janco recently completed 11 years as Director of the Rensselaer Program of Church Music and Liturgy at St. Joseph’s College in Rensselaer, IN. He continues to serve part-time as Director of Liturgy and Music at St. Eulalia Church, a multicultural parish in Maywood, IL. He is an active composer, perhaps known best for his widely used Mass settings. He has written numerous journal articles, as well as introductions for four music documents included in *The Liturgy Documents*, Volumes One and Three, and is a frequent conference and workshop presenter. He earned the Master of Church Music degree in composition from Concordia University Chicago and the Doctor of Ministry degree in liturgy from Catholic Theological Union, also in Chicago.
