Notable:

- **The Basilica of the National Shrine of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary**, also called the Baltimore Basilica, was the first Roman Catholic cathedral built in the United States
- **My Sister's Place** - resource center for homeless and impoverished women and their children providing housing assistance, health care services, education and life skills opportunities, case management, personal services and links to other community providers.
- **The Enoch Pratt Free Library** - Gifted to the City of Baltimore on January 21, 1882 by philanthropist Enoch Pratt who declared the library "shall be for all, rich and poor without distinction of race or color, who, when properly accredited, can take out the books if they will handle them carefully and return them."
