## A MESSAGE FROM JIM HAMILTON, CHAIR APPEAL ALLOCATIONS OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE

Dear Friends,

As Chairman of the Annual Appeal for Catholic Ministries' Allocations Oversight Committee, it is my pleasure to present you with this year-end review of the 2019 Appeal, *Our Faith, Our Future*. In this summary report, you will find:

- how your parish performed compared to its 2019 Annual Appeal goal,
- the top uses for Appeal monies that were rebated to parishes like yours, and
- a listing of how Appeal funds were used to strengthen the evangelizing and charitable outreach ministries that help the Archdiocese carry out the work of Christ every day.

Over 23,000 individuals, families, and philanthropic organizations came together in support of *Our Faith, Our Future* to raise \$9 million in gifts and commitments.

This remarkable outcome, especially during a challenging time for our Church, both locally and universally, speaks to the oft-unsung efforts of pastors, parish staffs and committees, Appeal lay co-chairs – John and Roslyn Balch and Glenn and Beth Falcao – guest speakers, and volunteers. If you gave of your time and talents in support of the 2019 Appeal, please be assured that your labors have been worthwhile. For through them, you have changed thousands of lives for the better, bringing your neighbors into a deeper relationship with Christ and His Good News and alleviating the ill effects of poverty for those helped through charitable outreach efforts sustained by the Appeal.

The Appeal's Allocations Committee, comprised of pastors, archdiocesan staff, and lay volunteers like me, meets twice a year and reviews Appeal funds raised to-date to ensure that they are used in accordance with the Appeal's Spending Plan. Because we are asked this question each year, I think it is important to reaffirm again here that your Appeal gifts are *never* used for purposes other than those stipulated in the Spending Plan, and are *never* used for legal costs incurred by the Archdiocese for any reason. Our committee takes very seriously our responsibility to make sure that your sacrificial gifts are being stewarded as you intend.

On behalf of Archbishop Lori, our Clergy and lay ministers, and those supported by our Archdiocese's many ministries that have been bolstered by your gifts, I again thank all of you who supported *Our Faith, Our Future*, in whatever ways you were able.

## MENSAJE DE JIM HAMILTON, PRESIDENTE COMITÉ DE SUPERVISIÓN DE LA CAMPAÑA ANUAL PARA MINISTERIOS CATÓLICOS

Queridos amigos,

Como presidente del Comité de supervisión de la Campaña anual para ministerios católicos, es un placer presentarles esta revisión de final de año de la Campaña de 2019: *Nuestra fe, nuestro futuro*. En este informe resumido encontrará:

- cómo su parroquia se desempeñó con relación a su meta de la Campaña anual de 2019;
- los principales usos del dinero de la Campaña que fue reembolsado a parroquias como la suya; y

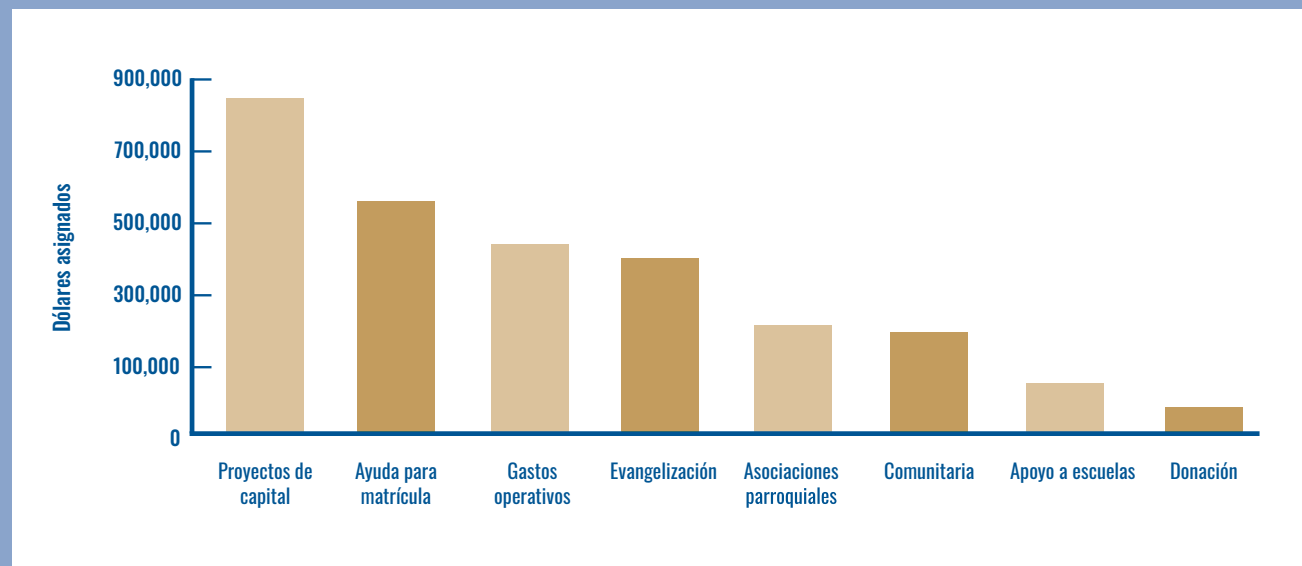
