Face coverings

The Archdiocese of Baltimore reminds clergy and laity that Maryland Gov. Larry Hogan issued a mandate effective July 31 (still in effect) that everyone over the age of 5 must wear a face covering (that fully covers the nose and mouth and is secured to the person's head) indoors at any location where members of the public are generally permitted, including religious facilities.
