As many of you know, the work of the church doesn't slow down for the summer, and we've been hard at work putting together virtual programming to keep you connected to spread the good news. We are working to celebrate the gifts and faith of the Black community, which is an integral part of our Universal Church.

September 12 – 30th Anniversary Celebration of Keep On Teaching

On September 12th at 1pm we will celebrate the 30th Anniversary of the *Keep On Teaching* program. *Keep On Teaching* is a catechetical ministry established to engage catechists to factor culture (both Black and Catholic) and its deep roots into their catechetical planning and implementation. This year's workshop theme is "A Dance Between Mystery, Meaning: Exploring the Liturgical Seasons". The featured speaker is Dr. Kathleen Dorsey Bellow. Dr. Bellow is a lifelong Catholic and is the director of the Xavier University Institute for Black Catholic Studies (IBCS.) IBCS is the first and primary national center for the study of the Black Catholic experience. Dr. Ximena DeBroeck, director of the Division of Catechetical and Pastoral Formation will also provide information to evangelize ourselves, our families, our parish and local community.
