## 7<sup>TH</sup> WEEK OF EASTER

*May 24-30*

### SUNDAY, MAY 24

*Matthew 28:16-20 The Great Commission (Ascension)*

How do I understand Jesus's command, "Go and make disciples"? Do I believe and accept my own call to invite others to follow Jesus? Am I acting on that? If not, what is one thing I could do today?

### MONDAY, MAY 25

*John 16:29-33 Do You Believe?*

Jesus speaks of tribulation and of peace. Are you able to feel the peace of Christ in our current circumstances? If not, how can you carve out some quiet time to seek God's peace?

### TUESDAY, MAY 26

*John 17:1-11 Jesus Prays for the Church*

Jesus accomplished the work the Father gave him. What work is the Father giving to me? Is He putting people in my life for a reason? Take some time to ask God about the work He wants you to do.

### WEDNESDAY, MAY 27

*John 17:11-19 God Guards Us*

When have you seen God at work protecting you from temptation? We ask God to, "lead us not into temptation," but do we thank Him for his protection?

### THURSDAY, MAY 28

*John 17:20-26 Prayer for Unity*

Jesus prays that all may become one. It is hard to feel unified as a Church when we cannot be with one another. How are you preparing for a return to the sacraments? Find out what your parish will be doing and how you can cooperate.

### FRIDAY, MAY 29

*John 21:15-19 Peter is Given a Command*

Jesus asked Peter three times, "Do you love me?" Would God have to ask me three times, or does He know I love him? How does He know? How do I show my love for God?

### SATURDAY, MAY 30

*John 21:20-25 Jesus and the Beloved Disciple*

Am I a disciple who bears witness to what God has done for me? Am I able to share my "testimony" of how God has acted in my life with others? If I have never shared my testimony, can I begin to prepare to do so?
