Over the years, the Archdiocese of Baltimore has reported hundreds of incidents of potential child sexual abuse to law enforcement, settled claims with more than one hundred survivors through our voluntary mediation program, and the Archdiocese's publicly available "List of Priests and Brothers Accused of Child Sexual Abuse" includes the names of 150 individuals.
