She is a board certified Internist and Fellow of the American College of Physicians.

She is a past president of the Catholic Medical Association (CMA); the nation's largest association of Catholic physicians and health care professionals. The CMA helps its' members grow in their faith, maintain ethical integrity, and promote excellent health care in accordance with the teachings of the Church. She is also a past president of its' local Baltimore Guild.

She has testified in the past on Capitol Hill in favor of the Conscience Protection Act of 2016. In 2019, she testified in Annapolis before the Maryland House of Representatives against Physician Assisted Suicide in the state of Maryland.
