### \* Social after Mass with Fr. Mike Depcik in Ijamsville


Please **bring your own bag lunch** to the social after Mass on May 21 in the classroom at the big church in Ijamsville. Drinks will be provided.

The Feast of Corpus Christi (the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ)

The Catholic Bishops of the United States have planned a three-year National Eucharistic Revival which began last year. Why? They want to renew the Catholic Church by emphasizing a living relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist.

As Catholics, **we believe that Jesus Christ is really and truly present (body, blood, soul, and divinity) in the Eucharist**. We celebrate this on Corpus Christi.



Archbishop William Lori will celebrate a special liturgy on the vigil of the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, Saturday, June 10 at 5 pm at the Cathedral of Mary Our Queen, 5200 North Charles Street, Baltimore, MD 21210. **You are invited to attend this special Corpus Christi celebration.** An interpreter will be provided. Following the Mass, there will be a procession around the outside of the cathedral with the Blessed Sacrament (the Eucharist).

#### Spiritual Mentoring in ASL Available for Women

"Hello, this is Marie Williams. I am a certified spiritual mentor after a two-year program at the School of Faith in Kansas City. What is a spiritual mentor? It is someone who would offer spiritual guidance and growth in information, insight and wisdom. It is a relationship between mentor, mentee and the Holy Spirit. Through this relationship, the mentee will discover what God is already doing in her life and how to grow in friendship/identity with God.
