This year the Chrism Mass is open to anyone who desires to attend. While those coming into the Church at the Easter Vigil are invited, seats will not be reserved online as they were in the past. We encourage all the laity of the Archdiocese of Baltimore to come together at the Chrism Mass. We recommend that they arrive early to acquire a seat. Pastors and leaders of religious orders and institutions will need to place an order for Holy Oils online prior to the Chrism Mass. Clergy and religious should also RSVP to ensure reserved seating.

2. Placing an Order for 2024 Holy Oils (Click HERE.)

Your Holy Oil order will be prepared for you and distributed after the Chrism Mass in boxed sets as we did last year. You do not need to bring your own containers, but you do need to let us know how much oil you are requesting. The online registration form gives you four options:

- 4 oz of each Holy Oil (1/2 cup each)
- 8 oz of the Oil of the Sick (*two, 4 oz. bottles*), 4 oz each of Oil of the Catechumens and Sacred Chrism
- 8 oz of Sacred Chrism (*two*, 4 oz. *bottles*) 4 oz each of the Oil of the Sick and the Oil of Catechumens
- 8 oz of each Holy Oil (1 cup each—2 boxed sets of 4 oz of each oil)

You may pick up your order as you leave the Cathedral. **Specific instructions for picking up the Holy Oils will be provided at the Chrism Mass.**
