Rescue One Training for Life, Inc.

The Department of Catholic Schools, in conjunction with Tom Alban and the Office of Risk Management, has identified a medical supplies vendor, Rescue One Training for Life, Inc., that has a physician on their staff who is willing to act as the medical director for any of our schools that have been unable to identify a physician to serve as their medical director to meet the requirement of the general use epinephrine program. (July 17, 2019 letter from Chancellor, Jim Sellinger)

2025-2026 process update:

Effective 2025-2026 school year, we have entered into an agreement with Rescue One, Training for Life, Inc. where they will supply a blanket script for ALL AOB schools for each of the following: General Use Epinephrine Pens, General Use Bronchodilator, and Nasal Spray Epinephrine. Risk Management will forward to your school a copy of the script. Please file this with your Epi Pen document records to comply with the program requirements.

<u>Important Note:</u> you will still need to complete the enrollment packet with Rescue One being named as the Medical Director to the Office of Risk Management. The document has been pre-filled with Rescue One where applicable. The completed packet along with the Rescue One blanket prescription should be held on file with the school records and available in the event of an audit.

<u>To Complete Enrollment:</u> Sign, complete, and return Appendix H of both the Epi Pen Program packet and the Bronchodilator packet to riskmanagement@archbalt.org. You no longer need to submit the full packet.
