

Ascension Saint Agnes Primary Care

The Department of Catholic Schools, in conjunction with Tom Alban and the Office of Risk Management, partnered with a physician from Ascension Saint Agnes Primary Care to act as the medical director for ALL of our schools as the medical director to meet the requirement of the general use epinephrine program.

2026-2027 process update:

This 2026-2027 school year, we have entered into a blanket agreement with Ascension Saint Agnes Primary Care where they will supply a blanket script for ALL AOB schools for each of the following: General Use Epinephrine Pens, General Use Bronchodilator, and Nasal Spray Epinephrine. Risk Management will forward to your school a copy of the script. Please file this with your Epi Pen document records to comply with the program requirements.

Important Note: you will still need to complete the enrollment packet with Ascension Saint Agnes being named as the Medical Director to the Office of Risk Management. The document has been pre-filled with Ascension Saint Agnes where applicable. The completed packet along with the Ascension Saint Agnes blanket prescription should be held on file with the school records and available in the event of an audit.

To Complete Enrollment: Sign, complete, and return Appendix H of both the Epi Pen Program packet and the Bronchodilator packet to riskmanagement@archbalt.org. **You no longer need to submit the full packet.**
